

Decatur Dream Center Women Program Outline

I Entrance

1. Entry Assessment
 - Applicant is mailed Assessment form to complete and mail, fax, or bring in to Program Director for review.
 - Acceptance or Denial letter will be mailed back to applicant. Upon acceptance, persons name will be added to waiting list or brought into the program at this time.
2. Intake
 - In depth intake form will be completed.
 - Non-refundable \$200 entrance fee will be taken.
 - Tour, overall rules and guidelines, settling in.

II Program Phases

1. Orientation Phase – Melting – Psalms 22:14
 - 4-10 weeks, Probation period.
 - Required to attend all classes, voluntary work therapy, no outside work at this time.
 - Work through life story and Step I of Christian Twelve Steps.
 - Entrance will be decided by Women’s Program Director.
 - No personal phone calls, no visitation or passes at this time.
 - It very important that you understand how detrimental this 30 day period is. Your actions and attitude will determine your entrance into the program.
2. Phase I – Pouring – Psalms 62:8
 - 6-10 weeks of pouring out, to prepare to be molded.
 - Work through “My Identity in Christ” and steps two and three.
 - May not work outside of Program.
 - Attend all classes, and work therapy.
 - Counseling will begin, at least 1 hour per week.
 - One three hour pass may be taken during this phase.
3. Phase II- Molding-Matthew 7:24-27
 - 13-17 weeks, setting goals for your life.
 - Work through “Search for Significance” and step four.
 - Enroll in GED classes if needed.
 - Marriage counseling if needed.
 - Attend all classes.
 - May begin outside work therapy w/approval of Program Director.
 - Continue counseling.
 - One 48 hour pass and one 8 hour pass per month may be taken with approval by the Program Director.
4. Phase III – Shaking – Galatians 5:22
 - 13-17 weeks, develop the ability to withstand the storms of life.

- Work through “The Mind of Christ” and Christian 12 steps five - twelve.
 - Continue outside W/T.
 - Meet with your counselor at least once every 2 weeks.
 - Two 48 hour passes per month and one 8 hour pass per month may be taken during this phase with approval from the Program Director.
 - Your tree should bear fruit now.
5. Phase IV – Cleansing and Grinding – Ephesians 2:19-22
- 16-24 weeks, this phase carries its own guidelines, and prepares you for your move to society.
 - Work through “How to Manage Your Money”.
 - Must have GED, and a plan for graduation.
 - Required to work a full time job.
 - Passes remain the same as Phase III, unless you have approval to go outpatient.
 - Continue counseling once every 2 weeks.

GRADUATION!

Total Program may vary depending of each individual need. All curriculums are Bible Based. Drug and Alcohol testing will be given often and at random.

Passes will be given by Program Director, according to each person’s environmental circumstance.

Each resident will be monitored at all times, and all program rules will be enforced with no discrimination.
